

The intent is for state classified employees to understand the work of the council, ask questions, and learn more about how to participate.



Did you know that FM has the most state classified employees of all departments and groups at CSU? Employee councils are an important part of shared governance, giving employees a voice and allowing them to actively participate in making positive changes at CSU. CPC represents CSU state classified employees on issues such as raises, parking, work-life balance, supervisor training, and employee recognition, while also contributing to university committees across campus.

Additionally, CPC regularly invites CO WINS representatives to attend CPC meetings to share information. State classified employees, working half-time (50%) or more, who have worked at CSU for at least 1 year are eligible to serve.
