


FM DAILY COMMUNICATION



Dear FM Staff,

The university has issued communication (see the attached FAQ) regarding CSU's intent to be open in the fall, including the plan to offer in-person classes and an on-campus experience.

We will prepare for this future while remembering that the university is required to follow public health guidance to protect our students and community. If CSU's status remains scaled back, CSU will work within those restrictions to provide housing for students in a manner that is consistent with university and public health guidelines. If the University status changes from remote or virtual operations to full in-person operations, residence halls and apartment buildings will be open. The status of fall events will depend upon future public health guidance as well. As we are unable to predict the risk posed by the coronavirus in the fall, CSU will determine the status of operations in late summer. The spread of the virus during the summer and early fall months will continue to guide CSU's decisions, and the university is developing strategic contingencies for the various conditions that could occur.
