Transportation Services remains open and ready to help with all of your vehicle needs. Pitkin, Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Social distancing is important, so please, only one person in the rental office at a time.

Now is also the perfect time to get your FM vehicle repairs or preventative maintenance completed. Both the light- and heavy-duty shops are open and their ASE certified technicians are ready to help. Technicians are also taking advantage of this time and working on re-certifications and additional training, so they can keep the CSU fleet running safely.

While their charter bus operations are on hold due to COVID-19 related travel restrictions, their drivers are participating in training and taking extra time to thoroughly clean all the buses. In addition, some of the drivers, through a collaborative effort between CSU and the Larimer County Food Bank, are delivering food throughout the Loveland and Fort Collins area. The drivers are enjoying this great opportunity and CSU has received many words of appreciation for the assistance. It is not uncommon for the drivers to receive three to four thank you calls a day, expressing that without them, the family would not have food. Since mid-May, they have made approximately 400 deliveries to homebound seniors.
