

Today we are excited to share that the FM Engagement and Recognition Committee (ERC) is looking for new members!

This team has worked together to provide FM employees with daily recognition through the SPARK program as well as department-wide events, such as Donut Day, Summer Ice-Cream Social, Chili Cookoff, and the 2020 Mask Contest. As of April 1, 2021, the ERC has given out over 1,600 gift cards for displays of department values.

We are striving for more diversity within the committee from all sections and groups in Facilities Management. This helps to ensure events can reach as many employees as possible and offer new perspectives. Creativity and a passion for adding excitement to the workplace are highly encouraged.
