Greetings FM Team,

This week's communication is an update on Building Services, including pictures they have shared from their teams.

Custodial has stayed busy, using their time to carry out project work. Custodial polished 5,000 sq. ft. of hallway at Moby during construction. The project was started and then put on hold due to issues with the floor. When those issues were resolved, it took one team to complete the project in a week's time. Custodial Operations are working on rotating shifts. Currently they work 4-hour shifts to maintain, disinfect, and ensure our buildings are kept up, all the while supporting social distancing and practicing healthy habits.

They have been very flexible, and their demanding work deserves notice!

The Integrated Solid Waste crew has been busy painting dumpsters, washing bins, and attending to the routes for recycling, cardboard, and trash pick-ups while the Compost crew has been occupied with washing bins, cleaning the compost site, and picking up compost materials. During the spring they sifted 423 cubic yards of finished compost. (Watch this short [video](#) of the sifting process!) They have 190 cubic yards ready to be sold or bagged, and 233 cubic yards curing that will soon be ready.
