

Dear FM Team,

The Employee Housing Programs was launched this past April in response to increasing concerns of quality, affordable housing for CSU employees. On August 23 they sent a survey; each employee received a unique link through their CSU email to open this questionnaire. If you have not yet had a chance to provide feedback, please do so soon. This survey is very important and closes on **September 13.** Your response to this survey will help CSU better understand employees' housing needs. The goal is to address barriers to quality, affordable housing for CSU employees.

The survey is available in English and Spanish, in both electronic and printed forms. The information you provide is confidential and anonymous; personal information such as name, CSU ID, IP address, and electronic device is not tied to the survey. The questions are comprehensive and ask about: current housing experiences; what employees' future housing goals are; and what programs they are most likely to participate in. Some of the questions focus on employees who live in Northern Colorado, but regardless of location, it is helpful for all employees to take time to share about their housing needs. Supervisors are aware that employees will need 15-20 minutes to fill out the assessment during the work day.
