The E-bike has multiple speeds and maneuvers slightly different from a standard bike. The downhill momentum when riding the E-bike from south campus to main campus, for instance, is probably faster than you realize. FM project manager Zack Kulbeck recently used the E-bike to get around to his different projects on main campus. "As you peddle it kicks in the extra inertia, but it's a heavy bike, so make sure you allow plenty of room and time to stop. It doesn't stop on a dime."
